**Open Call of the Days of Contemporary Art (DOCA) international festival 2022.**

**We invite artists to take part in the 10th Days of Contemporary Art (DOCA) international festival.**

**The festival's topic is 'WHAT IS YOUR NAME'**, This is the phrase exchanged at the beginning of a conversation. It signals the beginning of our contact, and stands as a sign that we are ready for conversation. Behind this phrase is the desire to know another. The DOCA festival as a place and event creates a system of relationships and projects a new landscape of subjectivity. DOCA is a meeting place that produces a unique community, a paradoxical space formed and embodied simultaneously by all yet owned by none.

That is a field where the New Subjectivity emerges on the edge of fractures and cracks.

**The main programme of the festival will take place on April 16-17, 2022 at the Institute for the Humanities and Information Technologies (IGUMO).**

**We invite:**

- artists working with different media (painting, graphics, installation, sculpture, photography, video art, media art, and performance) to participate in the main programme of the festival;
- musicians to take part in the music programme of the festival;
- artists, photographers, musicians, and designers to deliver workshops;
- speakers and educational institutions with scientific and creative activities related to the topic of the festival.

**The organisers will take over the logistics and installation of the exposition. It is not anticipated that the fulfilment of the projects will be budgeted.**

The participants will be given five floors of the Institute including halls, the lobby, the foyer, and other spaces to exhibit their works.

**The applications are accepted until March 31, 2022.**
